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ABOUT THE VENUE

Youth exchange will be organized in Novi Pazar, Serbia. The city of Novi Pazar is the political, economic and cultural center of Sandžak, that is, the Raska region. It is situated in the star valley of the rivers Jošanica, Raska, Deževska and Ljudska, more precisely speaking at the mouth of Jošanica in Raska, in the center of the Novopazar field. It is surrounded by the mountains Golija from the north-west and Rogozno from the southeast and the Pestera Plateau on the west side. From Belgrade it is 280 km away from the Ibar highway, through Kraljevo and Raska. It is located on the section of the old road that leads through the Ibar highway towards Podgorica and the Adriatic Sea.

Novi Pazar is a multiethnic and multicultural environment. The majority population is Bosniak-Muslim, which makes up about 85 percent of the city's population. The remaining 15 percent of Novi Pazar residents are Serbs and Montenegrins.





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Novi Pazar has great potential for development of all types of tourism. From now on, people have visited this multiethnic and multicultural prospect in large numbers, where western and eastern civilizations meet, and they still do so today.

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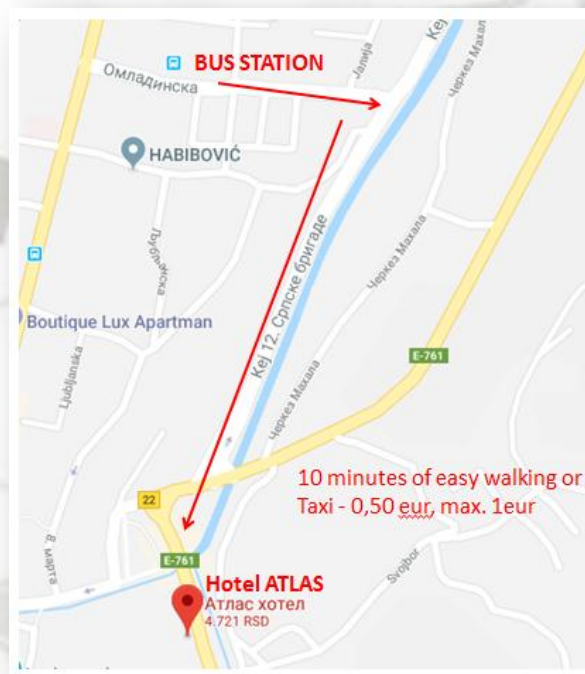
ACCOMMODATION

How to get from Airport to Bus station in Belgrade?

From the airport you can take public bus 72 to Zeleni Venac (500 meters from Bus station). Ticket cost is 150 RSD (1.3 euro). You can buy ticket from the driver.

Alternative transport is by A1 mini bus. In front of arrivals take mini-bus A1 going every 20 minutes toward Main bus and train stations. Timetable and map are on the link https://beg.aero/eng/parking_access/transport/public_transportation

Price of ticket is 300 RSD (app 2.5 EUR and it is sold by bus driver. Please exchange some EUR to RSD in arrival hall of the airport on right hand side after Customs check point. Bus and Train Stations are on first stop of A1 after bridge over Sava river.

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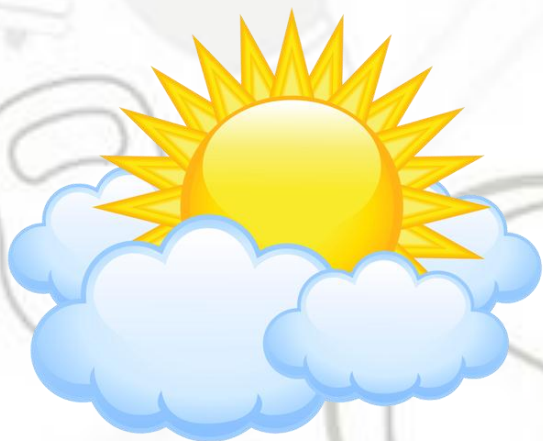


THE WEATHER

MONEY

The domestic currency is the Serbian dinar. The exchange rate is 1 € = approx. 118 RSD. You can exchange money in exchange offices and banks. We recommend you to exchange some money already in Belgrade, where you can find exchange offices in airport and bus station. Note that in Novi Pazar banks and the exchange office are open only during working days, from 8am till 4pm. Also, there are several cash withdrawal machines in Novi Pazar.
